I attended my parents' churches when I was growing up and didn't join a "real church" on my own until I moved to St. Louis in 1977. For the first few months, I did attend the Catholic church though the only thing I ever donated was my ability to play the guitar. After that, I mostly attended the campus chapels at Carleton College and Syracuse University. When I transferred to Washington University in St. Louis to finish grad school, I learned it had a chapel but no worship services, just an occasional wedding, funeral, or speech.

So, I went church shopping. I didn't return to those churches where the only people who talked to me were the minister and old ladies. I joined a (now) ELCA Lutheran church that welcomed me, providing Bible studies, women's groups, and fellowship activities. One couple even invited me to do my laundry at their house! These people became my St. Louis family. I supported the church enthusiastically. I couldn't contribute much, but I did contribute what I could. I knew the value of belonging to that congregation and the importance of supporting its ministry.

I've looked for those same blessings at churches I have joined since. It's true of St. Charles Episcopal, too, though I now do laundry in my own basement. And so, I support this church financially to the extent that I can. It's less now than when I was working full-time, but supporting SCEC is my top charitable priority. I am glad that those who visit our church find it to be welcoming and supportive. By supporting the stewardship campaign, we can all ensure that our church continues to be so.
