Dear Friends and Parishioners of St. Charles Episcopal Church,

This week we are moving into Holy Week and Easter and it is my hope that all of you will take time out of your busy schedule to join us for this sacred time. Holy Week shapes our lives as Christians more than any other as we remember the events of Jesus crucifixion, burial, and Resurrection. It begins on Palm Sunday as we commemorate Jesus triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Our service, which begins in Ludtke Hall, includes the blessing and distribution of palms. We will then process into the church for the Eucharist and Passion reading.

Please see our full Holy Week schedule in this newsletter. The Maundy Thursday Service begins with an Agape Meal at 6:30 p.m. in Ludtke Hall. The meal is the service and includes readings, the Eucharist and foot washing (For those who wish to participate). We will then move into the church for the stripping of the altar and go to total darkness. Our dinner menu is homemade lentil soup, cheese, olives, nuts, fruit and breads. Wine and non-alcoholic beverages will be served. The choir will be with us in the hall leading our music for this commemoration of Jesus last Supper. Let us

journey to the cross and the empty tomb together with a sense of how much we are loved by God.

- 7:00 p.m. Solemn Service with Veneration of the Cross.

April 20th - Easter Sunday

• 9:30 a.m. Holy Eucharist Service with Baptism.
